Robin Hood-Like Crime Wave Sweeps Madeira

So I pass a certified Canadian bank coming, right?" cheque across the desk to Jose Nunes, my Banif banker in Madeira and ask him to put it into the account of my friend John De Carvalho. It's a substantial amount, the annual payment to John who, after building my little house in Jardim Do Mar took back a portion of the mortgage. Jose's fast and efficient and I'm hoping this will take no more than a minute because I have more complicated transactions to do.

"The problem is," says Jose, "John only has a business account with Banif and this is a personal cheque."

After some debate, Jose picks up the phone and calls John in Johannesburg, South Africa where he's recovering from a serious cycling accident. John and I have a nice chat on Banif's dime and it's decided that I must drive to the capital of Funchal, almost an hour down the coast and deposit the cheque in John's personal account at the bank of Santander Totta.

I have other business to do which includes buying an English-speaking newspaper called the International Herald Tribune. It costs six dollars but I'm starved for news. I fully expect to see a photo of Toronto Mayor Rob Ford on the front page, drunk and urinating out his office window into the fountain at Nathan Phillips Square.

"This name is wrong," says the Totta teller. "No," I say. "I know this man personally and that is his name plus this is a certified bank cheque, good as cash and his bank account number is written on the back where my banker, Jose Nunes wrote it. Also Jose called ahead to tell you I was

"Yes, but the name on the cheque is not the name on this account.'

"His name is John De Carvalho, he's a friend of mine and I need to put this money in his account."

"I'm sorry but his name is not John De Carvalho. His name is Joao Francisco Gomez Carvalho."

"Well in Portuguese yes, but 'Joao' is 'John.' Carvalho is the same last name and the numbers match so cash the cheque already."

"But this is Portugal."

It has taken me three trips to the Electric Company, four documents, a meter reading and another trip to Banif for a fifth document just to get the correct name on my hydro bill so yes, I know this is Portugal.

"But that's his name in English and you've already confirmed the account number matches the name on the account of Joao Francisco Gomez Winnie Mandela Whatever Carvalho, so just cash the cheque and I'll be on my way." Apparently, I'm shouting at this point because the other tellers are looking our

After he tells me the name is wrong 22 times and he hears my rebuttal 22 times, I ask to see his supervisor. The assistant manager, a nice middle-aged woman who does not speak English comes to the counter. I explain that the certified cheque is as good as cash, the name is slightly different in English than in Portuguese but the account number is exactly the same and I understand that

this could be a problem if I was trying to take money out of this account. BUT I'M TRYING TO GIVE YOU THIS GODDAMN **MONEY** ON **BEHALF** OF ONE OF YOUR BEST CLIENTS WHOSE NAME HAPPENS TO BE JOAO FRANCISCO GOMEZ WINNIE MANDELA POPE FREAKIN' **FRANCIS** OF ASSISI WHATEVER CARVALHO!!!!

Things got pretty quiet in the bank. The place seemed eerily empty except of course for the 20 people now lined up behind me. The Totta Teller did the translating to his boss so for all I know they could have been discussing Portugal's \$286 billion debt crisis caused in part by bankers who actually did take money that unfortunately didn't belong to them.

The assistant manager took me gently by the arm and to her credit, instead of calling for security or escorting me out onto the street, she led me to a staircase, pointed up and said: "Director."

Now I'm sitting across from the bank's manager whose name is AH, TO HELL WITH IT! and as it turns out he knows my friend Joao Francisco Gomez Winnie Mandela Pope Freakin' Francis Cristiano Ronaldo Hugo Chavez Whatever Carvalho personally. Personally! Finally, we're getting somewhere!

"What do you want me to

do?" he asks.

"Well, I hope this doesn't come as a big surprise, but I would like you to cash this certified cheque into the matching account number of our mutual friend, the famous house builder John "D As In Deposit" Carvalho.

"Yes, but the name ..."

"Oh, no. I will not go 23 times on this, please call John and yes, I know he's in South Africa. So the manager calls John and we all have a nice chat on Totta's dime and the manager wishes him a speedy recovery, hangs up the phone and says: 'I'm sorry, there's nothing I can do. We cannot accept this cheque."

I know I'm beat at this point because it's obvious there must be a lot of suspicious characters like myself in Portugal, trying to deposit money in other peoples' accounts. It's like a highly illegal Robin Hood-like crime. The International Monetary Fund is currently giving Portugal a \$110 billion dollar bailout to keep them from declaring bankruptcy. From personal experience - unless the IMF officials go charging in wearing masks, carrying guns and screaming "Take all our money now!!!" - I just don't think Portuguese banks will accept this kind of deposit.



In The Loop

The regular Council meeting of June 25th lasted approximately 10 minutes. There were no questions or any Councillor reports.

However, during the Special" In Camera" Meeting which followed, Council approved a NOJHL Junior "A" hockey team for Espanola. It must be mentioned that during the initial information session on March 18th residents were assured that having a Jr. A Team would cost the taxpayers nothing or it would not be approved by Council. We trust that this will be the case and wish the new franchise a long and successful stay in Espanola. During the same "In Camera" meeting

During the same "In Camera" meeting the following decisions were made by Council:

- to list the building at 91 Tudhope Street for \$175,900 and sever the park and green space which then remains the property of the Town. The building at 91 Tudhope will have only one (1) designated parking spot. - to join with Dryden to share the cost of legal representation to seek the right to appeal the Domtar assessment. (NOTE: Espanola does not have the funds to repay this debt.)

As a cost cutting measure, the annual pool maintenance shutdown has been extended. The Pool will be closed from June 29th to August 6th.

Due to lower than expected enrolment numbers, the Summer Parks' program has been revised In addition to the original half-day program there will be a 3 week and a 1 week full day session offered. There were no questions or discussion on how this will work or how it will affect the students responsible for administering these programs.

Public Notice from Domtar's Espanola Pulp and Paper Mill

An integral part of our pulp and paper operations at Espanola is our effluent treatment system which consists of settling basins for solids removal and an aeration basin to treat the organic losses from the mill. This effluent treatment system ensures that the mill effluent doesn't adversely impact the Spanish River but, as a result of its design, is a source of odour. The following paragraphs outline steps that we are taking to address this issue.

Several factors have converged resulting in the higher-than-normal odour levels:

- Warm weather—as the temperature of the effluent increases so does the associated odour
- Higher than normal levels of effluent requiring treatment;
- Optimizing of mill chemical processes—as the mill recycles more of its production chemicals higher levels of odour occur.

Over the years we have implemented a number of measures to reduce the odour and we continue to take steps to address the cause of the odour. Over the past winter we have worked with a number of independent technical specialists to identify solutions including:

- Implementing new operating procedures to reduce odour-causing emissions (effective May 24, 2013);
- Continue to improve equipment reliability and performance to prevent operating upsets and minimize odour;
- Reviewing and modifying operating procedures of the effluent treatment system to optimize its operation and minimize odour
- Installing additional equipment in 2013 to improve the effectiveness of the effluent treatment system

We appreciate your understanding as we work through this improvement process and we regret any inconvenience this may cause.

Recipe

My son loves pesto and prefers pasta dishes without a tomato base, so I thought this would be the perfect pasta dish for him to try while home for the summer. I was grilling chicken breasts so I decided to make the recipe



omitting the chicken. This recipe can be made with or without the chicken. I didn't have pesto prepared even though I do have basil growing in the garden, but lazy me did have a tube of pureed basil from the produce department at the grocery store. It worked wonderfully and kept the preparation simple. I used 1 cup of half and half cream and ½ cup of milk because that's what I had in the fridge, but it also cuts the calories a bit. It turned out creamy and delicious and my son gave me his stamp of approval to make it again.

Penne with Chicken and Pesto

- 2 cups penne pasta
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 4 skinless, boneless chicken breast halves cut into thin strips
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- salt and pepper to taste
- 1 1/4 cups heavy cream
- 1/4 cup pesto
- 3 tablespoons of parmesan cheese

Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Add pasta and cook for 8 to 10 minutes or until al dente; drain. Heat butter and olive oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Sauté chicken and garlic until chicken is almost cooked. Reduce heat and stir in salt, pepper, cream, pesto and Parmesan cheese. Cook until chicken is no longer pink inside. Stir in cooked pasta.

*If not using chicken, sauté the garlic in the butter and oil, reduce heat and stir in the rest of the ingredients. Simmer sauce until slightly thicken. Add the pasta and toss.


Kids Korner

Painted Turtles

- Roundish rock
- Scissors
- 3 wooden craft spoons (or similar wooden shapes found at local dollar stores)
- Tacky glue
- Acrylic paint
- Googly eyes

Look for a clean, roundish rock about 2 inches wide. For the legs; use scissors to cut two wooden craft spoons in half. With tacky glue, attach those four pieces to a third craft spoon as shown. Glue the rock on top of the craft spoon assembly. Let the glue set. Decorate the turtle with acrylic paint, and add a pair of googly eyes.
