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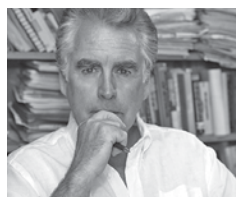
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All The World's A Circus

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Recipe

These melt in your mouth cookies are buttery and rich, probably because the ratio of butter to sugar is 2:1. Normally in cookies, there is more sugar than butter. They don't flatten because there is also a lot of flour. I prefer these cookies with pecans but you can also use walnuts or almonds (and even mini chocolate chips). Using a 1 tablespoon cookie scoop makes them evenly sized and if you want them a fun bite size you can cut them in half before baking.



Russian Teacakes or Snowballs

- 1 cup butter, softened
- ½ cup powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 2 ¼ cups flour
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ¾ cup finely chopped nuts (pecans, walnuts, or almonds)
- Powdered sugar for rolling

Preheat oven to 375°. Line two cookie sheets with parchment paper. Mix butter, ½ cup powdered sugar, and vanilla with an electric mixer until fluffy. Add flour and salt and mix until the dough comes together. Stir in the nuts. If dough is too soft, chill it until you can work it easily with your hands. Scoop 1 tablespoon balls of dough and place on prepared cookie sheet. Bake cookies for 7-8 minutes until bottoms are just slightly brown. Remove from oven and cool for just a minute, until you can handle them. Fill a small bowl with powdered sugar and roll each cookie in the sugar until coated. Place on a rack to cool. (Once cookies are cooled, you may want to re-roll them in more powdered sugar to make them look more powdery.)
