
Construction Continues At Brentwood Village In **Espanola**



Construction is well underway for Phase 2 at Brentwood Village in Espanola. Olivadel Developments has extended the new street on Yusko Crescent, which will be completed with asphalt and a walking boulevard later this Summer. New garden homes are available for sale or lease, designed exclusively for mature adults (55+) and seniors, with occupancy as early as July.

With Phase 1 successfully complete in 2019, Olivadel sold 3 units of a triplex, and leased 4 units of a 4-plex. In 2020, Phase 2 offers 7 garden homes for sale (2 sold), and 4 garden homes for lease (only 2 left). Phase 3 in 2021 will feature 5 garden homes for sale (1 already sold), plus 4 more for lease. A total of 12 garden homes of the 27 constructed will continue to be designated for

Noojmowin Teg Supports Families

By Rosalind Russell - Assisting First Nation members with health care is the main mandate of the Noojmowin Teg in Espanola and on Manitoulin Island, but thanks to partnerships, it can also be the conduit to helping out the wider community.

Executive Director Pamela Williamson says they agency received 250 packages containing diapers and books in a bag from Domtar for distribution to various community agencies and family programs. She says Dan's Towing of Espanola provided the transportation to distribute them.

Williamson says, in turn, the packages will now be distributed to those in need including Child Prevention Services in Wilkwemkoong, the Manitoulin Family Resource in Mindemoya, the Massey Food Bank, Our Children, Our Future program in Espanola and the Espanola Family Health Team.

The project was launched as part of the local Earth Choice Comfort and Care Program for Earth Week of 2020.

Recipe

I'm not going to lie; I love I when I'm given a recipe by I someone who has made it, I and highly recommends it. It makes this job a whole lot leasier. I often try new recipes, I hoping it will be a winner that



I can put it in my column. Unfortunately, the last few recipes that I have tried haven't made the cut. My friend texted me the other day and said, "I have a great muffin recipe for you, they are delicious!" SOLD! Send it on over. Essentially, it's strawberry shortcake in a muffin form. The batter will be thick and sticky, so gently fold the strawberries in. Pockets of juicy strawberries, in a buttery, I shortcake style muffin; sounds good to me!

I Strawberry Shortcake Muffins (yield 12 muffins)

- • 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ½ tsp salt
- 3 tsp baking powder
- ½ cup cold butter, do not substitute with margarine
- ½ cup white sugar, plus extra to sprinkle on top
- 1 cup milk
- 2 cups of chopped strawberries, 1/8-inch bits

In a large mixing bowl, sift or whisk flour, salt and baking powder. Cut butter into small pieces and mix into flour with a pastry cutter, two knives or use your hands until mixture is crumbly. Stir in sugar. Add milk and stir until just combined. Gently fold in chopped strawberries. Don't over mix the berries, or they will bleed into the batter. Scoop (approximately ½ cup) into well greased or lined ■ muffin tins, sprinkle tops with a pinch of sugar. Bake at 400 degrees ■ for 20 minutes. The tops will be slightly golden, and a toethpick • inserted into the middle should come out clean.
