#### No Action By Council To Save School

The Rainbow Community Non-Profit Housing group made a presentation to Espanola council in hopes of delaying the demolition of a local school. Housing chair Lynne Dee Sproule

says the housing situation in Espanola has changed since the Rainbow District School Board passed the motion to demolish AB Ellis Public School in 2014. She says housing needs have risen but supply has diminished since then, so building 44 new one-and-two-bedroom apartments for lower-income residents and seniors is a viable option.

However, no motion was put on the floor by council and no questions were asked. Mayor Jill Beer says council will review the reports and if there is any movement, it could be presented by the next council meeting.

The Ministry of Education has approved the demolition of the school this summer at a cost of \$2.7 million dollars.

### Town Of Espanola Police Board To Receive Community Safety And Well-Being Grant

The Town of Espanola received some great news to help the region develop a community safety and well-being plan.


The town and its partner communities, the townships of Sable-Spanish, Nairn & Hyman and Baldwin will share in a grant of just over \$281,000 over the next three years under the Ministry of the Solicitor General's Community Safety and Policing Grant.

Espanola Police Services Board Chair, Bill Foster says the proposal submitted by the police board focused on resources to implement the plan bringing together the relevant organizations in the region.

He adds the main priorities identified in the plan developed last year through community consultation are mental health and addictions, affordable housing, access to services, and seniors.

With the funding in place, stakeholders will now work together to move forward with the plan.

#### **Ontario Auditor Finds Laurentian University's Planned Bankruptcy**

that Laurentian University had to claim bankruptcy, but strategically planned for

Ontario Auditor General Bonnie Lysyk said she believes Laurentian University did not have to file for creditor protection under the Companies Creditors' Arrangement Act, but it chose to take steps to file for creditor protection in the Ontario Superior Court of Justice on February 1st, 2022.

Lyskyk says in her view, there were many people hired by Laurentian who were more focused on laying the track that guided the train toward the bankruptcy process, and less on working co-operatively and

The Ontario Auditor does not believe with full transparency with the Ministry of Colleges and Universities and faculty and staff labour unions.

> Her 13-page preliminary report on Laurentian University's finances was released publicly, adding her office plans to work with Laurentian's new chair and board of governors to finalize a comprehensive special report and release it soon.

> Laurentian University continues to undergo court-supervised restructuring after declaring insolvency more than a year ago, a process which has been extended a couple of times by the courts. It is not known when that process will end bringing Laurentian out of bankruptcy.


