
### The Water Walker Released To The Public

### REDUCED LOADS ON MUNICIPAL ROADS

### RADON DETECTOR

Radon is a radioactive gas that occurs naturally when the uranium in soil and rock breaks down. It is invisible, odourless and tasteless. When radon is released from the ground into the outdoor air, it is diluted and is not a concern. However, in enclosed spaces like homes, it can accumulate to high levels. High radon levels can be a risk to the health of you and your family. The Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers has purchased a portable Radon Detector that residents can sign out in order to test Radon levels within their home. Please ask at the front desk.
