isolation room that meets infectious disease standards, and to support upgrades to resident care and service areas to maintain infection prevention control and safe distancing. Other improvements and enhancement are a renovated shower room, much needed storage and renewed activity room and courtyard. The project does come with funding, however, there is a shortfall.

The Foundation immediately agreed to help raise \$450,000 to offset the cost of some of the renovations.

"The Hospital and Foundation are elated to announce the single largest private donation the Foundation has ever received!" Terri Noble, Foundation/ Public Relations Coordinator. "Longtime Espanola resident Daphne Allen has given a gift of \$150,000 to the project and we are so very grateful for her generousity." 
