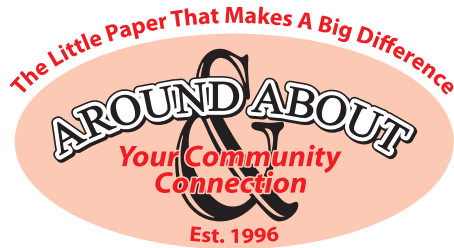

Both group of students took part in a flag-raising ceremony, a scavenger hunt and were offered a barbecue lunch. The provincial Franco-Ontarian day, celebrated officially since 2010, will take place on September 25. The date marks the anniversary of the Franco-Ontarian flag, which was flown for the first time in Sudbury in 1975. NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING CONCERNING PROPOSED ZONING BY LAW AMENDMENTS

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers will hold a public meeting on the 25th day of October 2023, at 6:30 p.m. in Council Chambers, 11 Birch Lake Road, Massey, Ontario, to consider proposed Zoning By-law Amendments under Section 34 of the Planning Act.

ZBA23-04 – The purpose of this proposed Zoning By-law amendment is to add short-term accommodations as a permitted use within the Resource Recreational (RR) and Rural (R) Zones. The amendment applies throughout the entire Township.

ZBA23-05 – The purpose of this proposed Zoning By-law amendment is to amend Table 4.32 – “Requirements for Storage Containers and Storage Trailers” to allow storage containers in the Residential (R1) Zone. The amendment applies throughout the entire Township.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers on the proposed zoning by-law amendment, you must make a written request to the Township.

ANY PERSON may attend the public meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of, or in opposition to, the proposed By-law Amendment.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township before the proposed By-law Amendment is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting, or make written submissions to the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers before the decision is made, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Tribunal, unless in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
