

Rainbow District School Board Welcomes 13,996 Students On September 6th



Rainbow Schools

Reaching minds. Touching hearts.

According to official predicted enrolment for the start of the 2023-2024 school year, Rainbow District School Board will welcome 13,996 students in Rainbow Schools when classes resume on Wednesday, September 6, 2023.

In the elementary panel, enrolment will total 9,133 students including 6,484 in the English Program and 2,649 in French Immersion.

In the secondary panel, enrolment is expected to reach 4,863 students including 4,134 in the English Program and 729 in French Immersion.

Enrolment is calculated as full-time equivalents.

This fall, 1,541 children are expected to be enrolled in Kindergarten in Rainbow Schools, a full-day program for four and five-year-olds.

A total of 1,093 students have registered for Grade 9 classes in area Rainbow Schools.

NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING Concerning an Application for Consent

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers will hold a public meeting to consider the proposed application for Consent under Section 53 of the Planning Act, RSO 1990 as amended. The public meeting will be held on **Wednesday, September 27th, 2023 at 6:30 p.m.** in Council Chambers, at 11 Birch Lake Road, Massey, Ontario.

Consent File No. C-23-12 Purpose and Effect: To provide for the creation of a new lot within the Rural zone. The property is described as Salter Township, Concession BF, PT Lot 4, Parcel 5190. The land in subject application is not subject to any other Planning Act application.

TAKE NOTICE that if you wish to be notified of the decision of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers on the proposed application, you must make a written request to the Clerk of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers. To appeal the decision to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal, send an appeal form to the Clerk of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers outlining the reasons for the appeal. You must enclose the applicable appeal fee for each application appealed, paid by cheque, made payable to the Ontario Minister of Finance.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers before the bylaw is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting, or make written submissions to the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers before the decision is made, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Tribunal, unless in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.




