With summer in full swing, families aren't only thinking about vacation time; they are also contemplating moving. This is music to a buyer's ear, because it means that the multiple offer situations are cooling off for now. We anticipate a strong market heading right into fall, but we'll check in again next month to see how things are shaping up.
