Expressions of Interest for Council Vacancy

During the Regular Meeting of Council of June 25, 2024, one (1) Councillor position was declared vacant.

The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Subsection 263 (1) requires that the Municipality shall:

(a) fill the vacancy by appointing a person who has consented to accept the office if appointed; or

(b) require a by-election to be held to fill the vacancy in accordance with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996. 2001, c. 25, s. 263 (1).

Following the decision of Council to fill the vacancy by appointment, the Town of Espanola is now accepting applications to appoint one (1) Councillor position for the remainder of the 2022-2026 term of Council.

All applicants must be a qualified elector as defined in the Municipal Elections Act. Applicants must be:

- A Canadian citizen;
- At least 18 years old, and;
- Resident of the Town of Espanola, or the owner or tenant of land in the Town of Espanola, or the spouse of such a person; and
- Not prohibited from voting (as per the Municipal Elections Act) or otherwise by law.

The role of Council as per section 224 of the Municipal Act, 1990 are:

- to represent the public and to consider the well-being and interests of the municipality;
- to develop and evaluate the policies and programs of the municipality;
- to determine which services the municipality provides;
- to ensure that administrative policies, practices and procedures and controllership policies, practices and procedures are in place to implement the decisions of council;
- to ensure the accountability and transparency of the operations of the municipality, including the activities of the senior management of the municipality;
- to maintain the financial integrity of the municipality; and
- to carry out the duties of council under this or any other Act. 2001, c. 25, s. 224; 2006, c. 32, Sched. A, s. 99.

and Sables-Spanish Rivers Township's Kevin Burke were in attendance for Nickel Belt MP Marc Serré's announcement of a \$49,000 grant towards supporting the new van, which will provide transportation for seniors and those with mobility issues throughout the region. (Baldwin Mayor Vern Gorham was unable to attend.)

A driver has been hired and is completing First Aid and CPR training. The service starts July 6th.

Users must register for transportation to and from medical appointments in Sudbury and Espanola.

The van is a joint project between the four municipalities that make up the LaCloche Foothills Mayors Association.

The federal government is investing \$49,370 through the Public Transit Infrastructure Stream of the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program. The Government of Ontario is investing \$41,138. The Town of Espanola, Township of Baldwin, Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers, and Township of Nairn & Hyman are contributing a combined \$32,917.

Young Massey Boy Receives Certificate For Saving A Girl's Life

By Rosalind Russell - Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers council hosted a special meeting July 8th to have a special guest to acknowledge his heroic efforts in trouble and swam to her rescue saving saving a young girl from drowning.

Andrea Pyette of Massey says her sevenyear-old daughter, Keira Weist was saved from drowning on June 20th by a 12-year-old boy, Carter Eshkakogan, also of Massey.

She says her daughter was swimming with friends at the Mouth Park when she

was caught by the current and was being pulled underwater.

Pyette adds Carter spotted Keira having her life, adding her daughter has received medical treatment and is now taking swimming lessons.

Word of his actions spread, and township council presented him with a Certificate of Bravery acknowledging his heroism at the special meeting.

Harvest Algoma Awarded Neighborhood Grant from The **Starbucks Foundation**

By Rosalind Russell - As part of The Starbucks Foundation's Neighborhood Grants program, Harvest Algoma was selected to receive a \$5,400 grant in feeding those in need in the Algoma District.

As a key player in reducing food waste and hunger in our community, Harvest Algoma focuses on sourcing wholesome food from local grocers, community

donations, and its own greenhouses.

This food, which might otherwise end up in landfills, is transformed into meals and excess shared with local farmers for animal feed or composted.

Harvest Algoma then stores distributes these meals across the district, so the grant will towards upgrading freezer units to store rescued food and prepared meals.
