United Church of Espanola Fully Accessible



By Rock Taylor - The official opening of the "LIFT" at UCE on November 9th of last year was the final stage of our church becoming fully accessible in accordance with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA). The law, enacted in 2005, aims to improve accessibility standards for people with disabilities, ensuring equal opportunities for participation in all aspects of life by 2025. The lift, connecting our main sanctuary floor with our lower hall was the final component of our access system which includes a new single slope ramp and a power door at the front of the church. Already in service is a hearing loop in the sanctuary that links our sound system to hearing aids to improve sound

The "ribbon" was "cut" by the arrival of Builders and the lift was engineered and first passengers Audrey Waddell and Jenni Taylor to the applause of representatives of all levels of governments, two former Ministers, leaders and members of the congregation. This project was financed with seed money from the sale of the Webbwood United Church, money provided by the Government of Canada's Enabling Accessibility Fund, private donations and ongoing fund raising. To all, thank you. All three elements of our access system were designed by Perry and Perry Architects, ramp, door installation

and shaft construction were by Quantum installed by Savaria.

This newly acquired accessibility means that the lower hall and kitchen, the chapel/ meeting room and the sanctuary are all available to those with mobility issues, including wheelchair use. Available for worship, for meetings, for lunches and dinners, for social times, for study and exercise, for celebrations and gatherings and for groups creating anything from quilts to music!
