By Rosalind Russell - The province has come through with funding for the Town of Espanola to replace the refrigeration system at the Espanola Regional Recreation Complex.

It's part of the \$200 million Community Sport and Recreation Infrastructure Fund.

Officials say the province-wide initiative helps communities revitalize local facilities, grow the economy and promote active, healthy living across Ontario.

Local MPP Bill Rosenberg was joined by Mayor Doug Gervais for the announcement of \$1 million to replace the ice plant with a state-of-the-art CO2
