Jesuits Transfer Spiritual Centre To Diocese - Now Designated A Pilgrimage Site



By Rosalind Russell - The Anishinabe Spiritual Centre has been designated a Jubilee 2025 Pilgrimage Site.

The Jesuits of Canada, which had overseen the centre located just south of Espanola over the last four decades, transferred the governance of the Anishinabe Spiritual Centre to a newly formed Board of Directors on Friday.

The board will be Indigenous-led and includes the participation of the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie.

Officials say Friday's gathering also included the designation of making it a Jubilee 2025 Pilgrimage Site by the Catholic Church, recognizing it as a sacred place of reflection, renewal, and reconciliation.

Pope Francis declared 2025 as a Jubilee Year.

Officials say pilgrims from across Canada and beyond will be encouraged to visit the Centre to experience its blend



of Indigenous and Catholic spirituality Fr. Jeffrey S. Burwell, SJ, Provincial, and participate in special programming. The Centre says the transfer solidifies decades of Indigenous involvement and vision in the Centre's programming and cultural teachings.

The new Board, made up of the former trustees, who are now considered directors, will oversee the Centre's operations, while maintaining strong ties to the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie, under the guidance of Bishop Thomas Dowd, for sacramental guidance and spiritual oversight.

The three-hour ceremony, led by local Indigenous representation included a storyteller and Elder, drum song, and the integration of First Nation beliefs Debbie Ense including the sharing of tobacco, Mona Jones strawberries and water.

Specifics of the ceremony are not Mary O'Donnell publicized falling in line with First Nation tradition of the sacredness of the ceremony, which concluded with the signing of the document officially transferring the Centre's governance.

The ceremony was attended by Espanola Mavor Doug Gervais. Algoma-Manitoulin MPP Bill Rosenberg, Elders,

Jesuits of Canada, Bishop Thomas Dowd, Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie, the new New Board of Director's & Members, including board chair Rosella Kinoshameg, as well as invited guests from the community at large under the guidance of the Centre's Executive Director Edwina (Eddy) MacDonald.

Following the formalities, Bishop Dowd and the Jesuits presented to everyone in attendance, and then shared in a community feast to mark the occasion.

Mock Trial Marks Award For Espanola High School Student

By Rosalind Russell - The Annual Mock High competed for the Hennessy Cup Trial Competition held at the Sudbury Court House involved students from several high schools including Espanola High School.

Regional Senior Justice Karen Lische of the Ontario Court of Justice says Grade 12 law students from Rainbow District School Board and Near North District School Board donned legal gowns to prosecute and defend an individual charged with "criminal harassment" contrary to the Criminal Code of Canada. She says close to 50 students from different schools, including Espanola earlier this month.

Justice Lische, says the cup went to Chippewa Secondary School students this year, with the silver medal going to Sudbury Secondary School, adding there were also several individual awards.

Espanola High's Nico Jacko was the winner of the Miller Maki (law firm) Best Witness Award.

She says the process allows students a glimpse into the law as a profession, adding students have the opportunity to better appreciate the presumption of innocence.


