World-Renowned Indigenous Artist From Espanola Has Passed Away - Michael "Cy" Cywink



By Rosalind Russell - An internationally acclaimed Indigenous artist from Espanola, Michael 'Cy' (sigh) Cywink, passed away late last week.

Cywink worked as an artist, curator, author, and muralist with his artwork showcasing his Indigenous heritage, including at local schools A. B. Ellis Public and Espanola High School.

Born in Little Current, he graduated from the Museum Studies Program at the Institute of American Indian Arts in

Eighteen-year-old Braiden Paul has been playing ball since he was ten years old, and is now heading to Chesapeake Junior College in Maryland to play with the Skipjacks. Braiden says he was working in the St. Charles School wood shop last October when

he cut off several digits on his right hand on a jointer. He says he doesn't remember the accident but thought his pitching days were behind him. However, after several surgeries, he picked up a baseball in January and discovered his throwing arm was not going to let him down. He adds that while most pitchers use two fingers along the seams of a baseball, causing the ball to dance in various ways, Paul now uses three. That success led to the scholarship and his chance to eventually play pro-ball, so he is heading down to the U. S. this summer, thankful he can still play the game he loves. World-Renowned Indigenous Artist From Espanola Has Passed Away - Michael "Cy" Cywink

Santa Fe, New Mexico, started exhibiting his artwork back in the 1970s and through the ensuing decades.

Cywink also interned with Walt Disney Imagineering, the National Museum of the American Indian and the Canadian Museum of Civilization and was also a curator with the Wikwemikong Art Gallery and the Ojibwe Cultural Foundation.

A published writer, a documentary-style video, "The Creation Story of Michael 'Cy' Cywink," was set to premiere alongside an intimate art show at the Blyth Festival Theatre Art Gallery and book signing of his short story, The

Adventures of Crazy Turtle, later this month.

It will now be held in tribute to his many contributions to the Indigenous art world. The public was invited to attend his final good-bye at the Whitefish River First Nation Community Centre on Wednesday, June 3, at 9 a.m.

Cywink was also a member of several artistic organizations, including the Aboriginal Arts Administrators Canada, Metis Artist Collective Canada, and Indigenous Curatorial Collective Canada. Cywink was 71.

Attorney General Award Presented To Wikwemikong Tribal Police Service Crisis Worker

By Rosalind Russell - A crisis worker with the Wikwemikong Tribal Police Service has been presented with a provincial award for her ongoing work with the agency.

According to the release, Amanda Gibbons was presented the Attorney General Award for Exceptional Achievements on Behalf of Victims and Victim Services in Ontario earlier this week.

Officials say the Wikwemikong Tribal Police Service Situation Table began in September 2025, with Gibbons playing an integral role in its planning and eventual implementation. The Situation Table is a risk-

driven, rapid triage approach that brings together multiple human service agencies (including police, mental health, addictions, housing, education, and child and family services).

To date, the WTPS Situation Table has brought together over 27 community partner agencies and provided referrals to over 30 community members.

Officials say Gibbons is an integral of the weekly table and has also joined the Provincial 'Multi-Sectoral Risk-Based Intervention Initiatives Community of Practice'.

Canada Post CUPW-Represented Employees Vote To Accept Tentative Agreements

By Rosalind Russell - The Canadian Union of Postal Workers has informed Canada Post that its members have voted to accept the tentative agreements for the Urban and RSMC (Rural and Suburban Mail Carriers) bargaining units.

Canada Post President and CEO Doug Ettinger says the parties will soon sign the new collective agreements, which will remain in place until January 31, 2029.

He adds that with the stability of new agreements in place, they look forward to working with the employees and bargaining agents to rebuild the business, restore confidence in the postal system and better serve the country.

The corporation suffered the highest loss in its history, over \$1.57 billion in 2025.

He adds while the process was challenging, these negotiated agreements recognize that Canada Post needs to change, so they can provide affordable weekend parcel delivery and make needed adjustments to the retail network while continuing to provide good-paying jobs across the country. The company's \$205-million loss before tax in the first quarter deteriorated by \$164 million compared to a loss before tax of \$41 million in the first quarter of the prior year.

Revenue fell by \$181 million, or 14.3 per cent, in the first quarter compared to the same period of 2025.

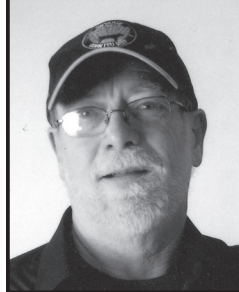

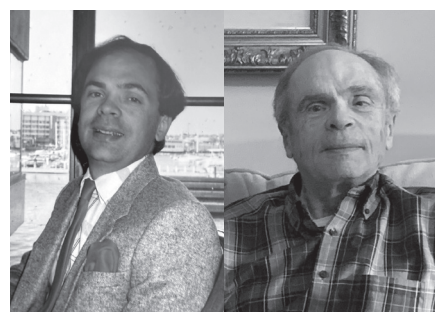

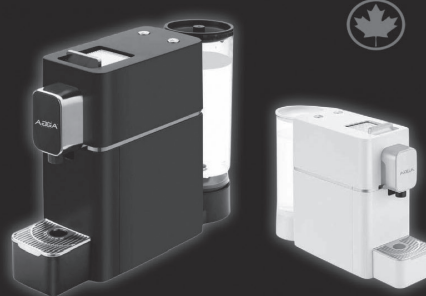
