On September 18, 2006, Corporal Shane Keating, Corporal Keith Morley, Corporal Glen Arnold of McKerrow and Byers were killed by a suicide bomber while on a dismounted patrol in Zhari District Centre, Afghanistan.

A graveside ceremony was held at the Espanola Cemetery followed by a gathering at the Legion hall.

Byers joined the Canadian Forces in 2003 and was a member of the 2nd Battalion, Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry, based in Shilo, Manitoba, at the time of his passing.

He was on his first operational tour when he deployed with the company to Afghanistan in August 2006.

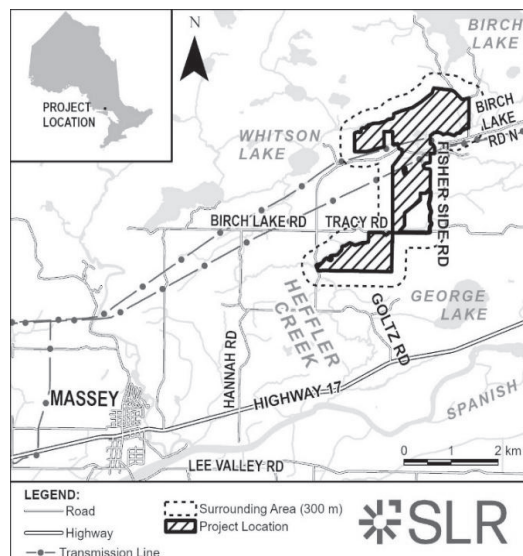

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Municipal Election: How to Vote in Sables-Spanish Rivers Twp

By Chloe Kneer - The municipal election in Sables-Spanish Rivers Township, which encompasses Webbwood, Massey and Walford, is shaping up to be a contentious one. There are 13 candidates running for 6 councillor spots, and 2 running for mayor. Altogether, 4 incumbents will be on the ballot. Not only are candidates' platforms top-of-mind, but so is the chosen voting method, which will be electronic only this cycle. In 2022, the township used a combination of electronic and telephone voting. Neighbouring municipality Espanola also adopted this method of voting in 2022. However, Sables-Spanish Rivers decided to drop the telephone voting option after complaints that it was too confusing with the number of options to sort through. In order to assist with making their voting process smooth, taxpayers will receive an informational flyer in the mail along with the township's newsletter in the coming week. Residents will also receive their Voter Information Letter 2 weeks before early voting opens at 10:00 am on October 14. Voting options include online from home or in person electronically at a polling location if assistance or a reliable internet connectivity is needed. If residents choose to vote at a polling location, they must bring their Voter Information Letter with them.

Polling locations will be the Massey and Webbwood libraries and the Township Municipal Office. Only the Township Municipal Office will offer after-hours Election Day voting (October 26) from 6:00 - 8:00 pm, so residents should plan accordingly.

Researchers Unlock History At Manitoulin's Sheguiandah Archaeological Site

By Rosalind Russell - One of Northern Ontario's most significant historical landmarks on Manitoulin Island continues to connect past and present through a collaboration between a Laurentian Professor Emeritus and a current student.

Located on Manitoulin Island, the Sheguiandah archaeological site was once the center of international debate after excavations in the 1950s suggested artifacts could date back 25,000 years.

According to the university, in the 1990s, a collaborative project brought in Dr. Patrick Julig, now a professor emeritus at Laurentian, to settle the timeline using geo-archaeology.

By analyzing soil sediments, radiocarbon dates, and ancient pollen records, Dr. Julig's team proved human activity at the ancient quartzite quarry dates back roughly 9,500 to 10,500 years—a landmark finding published in his 2002 book and built into the exhibits at the Centennial Museum of

Sheguiandah.

Today, that academic legacy continues through Laurentian history student Chris Hogge, a Manitoulin local who spent the last five seasons guiding visitors through the site's historical walking trail and interpreting the museum's exhibits.

Hogge says they have focused on conveying the rich scientific history of the site while respecting that the cultural stories belong to local First Nations to tell.

He adds that taking complex science and making it accessible to tour groups connects directly back to what he studied in my courses.

Dr. Julig adds that seeing Laurentian students today sharing this history with the public is a wonderful continuation of that legacy.

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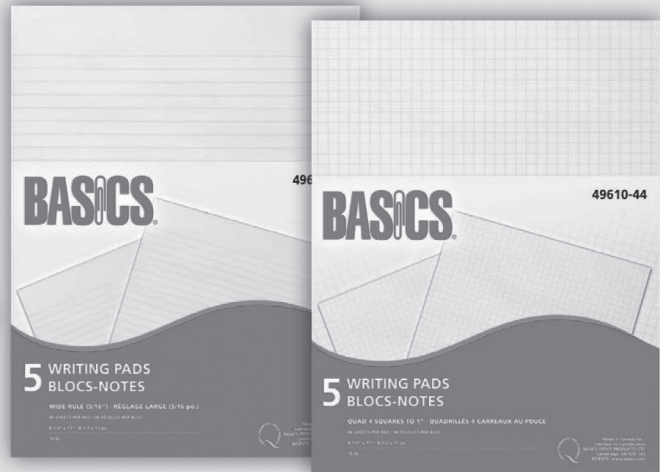
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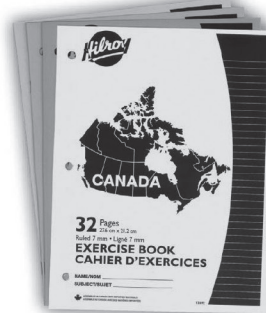


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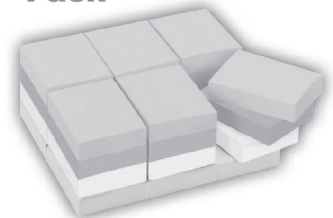
